2021 Plans

Pillar Inc was awarded the contract for the construction of the Pickleball Pocket Park and will begin construction at the end of May. Bids are out for the replacing 1.75 miles of the Linn Creek trail with pavement and crack sealing the remaining 5.5 miles of trail from Morris Park to Riverview Park. Con-Struct is resurfacing the entire 6th St Softball Complex parking lot and will be done by the end of June. .

Elks Park Planning Meeting

Staff and Park Board members met with around 15 neighborhood residents who gave their input on what amenities they would like to see improved within the park. The main consensus was to improve the basketball courts, update the play structures, and improve the open space for better play. Staff will be working on a plan to complete this work this year.
