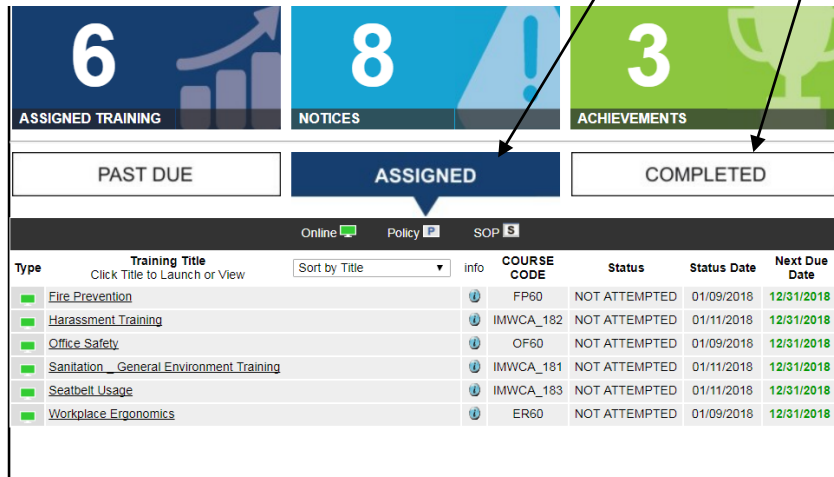
This screen will appear:



When this screen appears, click on "My Training"



The classes you are registered for will appear under ASSIGNED **AND** possibly under COMPLETED. Click on the course name and the class will begin.



The course will immediately start. If you need to exit out, when you go back in, it will start up where you left off. During the course or at the end there will be a quiz. If you do not pass the quiz, you can go back in and retake it.

FOR 2020 – when you click on the My Training tab, you will have to go to the ASSIGNED **AND** COMPLETED sections to see all of your training. Under the COMPLETED tab, it may show that you have PASSED the classes already. The system does not erase this status and start fresh each year with some of the courses. Unless there is a STATUS DATE of 2020 next to the PASSED status – you still need to complete this course for 2020.

Once you click on and start a course that is under the COMPLETED tab, if you need to leave the course and restart it later, the course will have moved to the ASSIGNED tab.
