	<b>Grading Plan:</b> Prepared by a licensed engineer or land surveyor showing proposed work, the boundaries and dimensions of the property the location of streets, sidewalks and sewers in the area of the property, and the actual location of the property where the proposed work is to occur. This would also include the property and other properties in the area sufficient to show topography drainage patterns existing facilities and vegetation and other natural features.
	<b>Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP):</b> Includes any other sketches, maps, studies, engineering reports, tests, profiles, cross-sections, construction plans and specifications the city may require to fully analyze the risk of erosion and pollution potential and the procedures available to prevent the same. Includes all required information in IDNR General Permit Number 2.
