### *ABOUT THE CITIZEN ACADEMY...*

The citizen academy provides community members an inside look at their police department. During the academy students will be introduced to a variety of topics as described under the curriculum outline.

The ten-week academy is designed to give citizens an overview of the police department's function and operational procedures. The curriculum and teaching methods are similar to the traditional police academy; however, the weekly sessions are not designed to train the participant as a police officer.

Academy classes are taught by police administrators and veteran police officers. Participants will have the opportunity to meet the Chief of Police and staff members. They are encouraged to ask questions and express ideas or concerns to police employees.
