Buena Vista University is thrilled to welcome the City of Marshalltown as a partnering organization! This new partnership offers education benefits to lower overall tuition costs associated with attending Buena Vista University online or on campus to full-time employees, as well as a spouse, domestic partner and dependents up to age 26 of full-time employees and part-time employees.

As a partner employee, you and your eligible family members qualify for up to a 30 percent discount per credit hour in the form of a BVU partner grant. This grant is for all online/hybrid undergraduate programs and our graduate program in Organizational Leadership. For those interested in attending our BVU Storm Lake campus, a BVU partner grant of up to \$2,000 annually will be available.

To be eligible for the BVU partner grant, please follow these steps:

1. Apply to Buena Vista University – www.bvu.edu/apply.
 - a. Select “City of Marshalltown” as your partner employer on the application.
2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). *This is required for undergraduate students and preferred, but not required for graduate students.*
3. Email or call Jill in Human Resources and she will submit your employment verification electronically confirming your employment.
 - a. Current BVU students are also eligible for grant funding. Current students will skip steps 1 & 2 and begin request for employment verification.
